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Online Safety Apps

MM Guardian -Parental control app offer a free 14 day trial. See <https://www.mmguardian.com> for more details if concerned about phone activity.

Pingo App- A companion app to Find My Kids, our app for parents. Please only instal this on a device used by a child or a teenager.

- **Gps Locator:** See your childs location on the map and the history of the days activity.
- **Sound Around:** Listen to whats going on around your child to make sure they are okay.
- **Loud Signal:** Send a loud signal to your child phone if they have misplaces it or on silent mode.
- **Parents control:** Find out what apps they they used/
- **Notifications:** Make sure your child is on time for school, back home and other place you've created.
- **Battery control:** Remind your child to charhe the phone on time.
- **Family chat:** chat with your child in the chat room with fun stickers and send voicemails.

Net Nanny-offers 3 annual subscription options, ranging from \$39.99 to \$89. They also offer a free version that comes with fewer features.

- GPS enabled location tracking – see your kid's location in real-time, view past locations, view locations on Net Nanny's Family Overview Map.

- Alerts – set up custom alerts per device for online searches
- Family Feed – overview of kids' online activity at a glance, available any time
- Parent dashboard – user-friendly dashboard to control all settings

- GPS enabled location tracking – see child's location in real-time
- Geofencing – set safe area parameters
- Battery Tracking – set notification alerts for when the child device battery is low
- Internet monitoring – set filters to block certain websites and content
