**Year 10 Geography and Art GCSE Trip to Liverpool, July 12<sup>th</sup> – July 13<sup>th</sup> 2024**

Dear Parents and Carers

The Geography and Art departments are proposing a joint residential trip to Liverpool on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> July until Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> July 2024. As there are many students this year studying both subjects, we thought it would be an ideal opportunity to take students to experience new things and see how a national city of culture can support their studies.

We would like to take the students to visit the main case study sites of the Liverpool regeneration programme that are used in the Paper 2 exam of the Geography GCSE and to visit several key inspirational art projects, including the Museum of Liverpool to inspire their Art portfolios for their GCSE Art coursework.

We will depart from school at 7.30am on Friday 12<sup>th</sup> July and will return to school on Saturday 13<sup>th</sup> July at 6.30pm where a prompt pick up will be required.

The proposed trip intends to include a study of Albert Docks, where we will be staying at the Youth Hostel. We will be taking a trip to Crosby Beach (famous for '**Another Place**', the sculpture by internationally acclaimed artist, Antony Gormley) and a river cruise on the Mersey, as well as a visit to the Liver Building and the Beatles Museum. We will be going on a guided tour of Anfield Park (as long as they have no match commitments) and will take in other sites of the regeneration project.

The total cost of the trip is £150 per student with **an initial deposit of £25 to be paid no later than the October 6<sup>th</sup>** and the remaining balance to be paid in full by 24<sup>th</sup> May 2024. Running the trip will be dependent upon enough students signing up to make the trip economical. On the other hand, there are a maximum number of 50 spaces available and if the trip is oversubscribed, names will be selected at random by the Senior Leadership Team. If your child is in receipt of Free School Meals, the school will make a contribution towards the trip – please contact me direct for details.

Attendance on the trip will be in line with the school policy on behaviour and attendance - both will need to be excellent during the year in order to take part. Students who are removed from the trip by the school due to behaviour/attendance, or who change their minds about going, will forfeit any monies already paid.
