**Year 7 Harry Potter Studios Trip – THURSDAY 4<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER**

On Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> and Friday 5<sup>th</sup> December, we are excited to be able to offer all of Year 7 the chance to visit the Harry Potter Studios, in Watford. **Your child will be attending on THURSDAY 4<sup>TH</sup> DECEMBER.**

In the next few weeks, Year 7 will be studying a Harry Potter scheme of learning to inspire their own creative writing. We hope that visiting the studios will be a fantastic opportunity for them to gain further inspiration for their stories, as well as seeing the different aspects that go on behind the scenes of turning a book into a film. We hope this will open their eyes to a world of careers that they may not have considered before, and be a memorable and exciting experience to be a part of.

**Transport and tickets** for the trip cost **£32.60** per student. This includes:

- Entrance ticket to Warner Bros. Studio Tour London (RRP: £45)
- A free digital download of the student's photograph in the green screen broomstick experience (physical copies may be purchased at a discounted rate)

Please pay via Parent Pay and complete the Teams (link at the bottom of the letter). Students in receipt of the Free School Meals will be partially funded by the school. Please ensure that this is completed by **Friday 28<sup>th</sup> November 2025.** The school, as with every trip, reserves the right to withdraw any student if their behaviour at any time up to the moment of departure is considered to have been poor; in this instance, no money paid will be refunded.

We will need to leave Fairfield promptly at 7am and therefore students should be **at school no later than 6:45am.** We should return to Fairfield by **8pm.** We will ask students to phone parents and carers when we are an hour away to give you a more precise time for collection. It will be a long day, but we think it'll be worth it.

Students will be expected to wear school uniform. A lot of schools visit on the same day, and it allows us to keep everyone safe. Students will need to bring a packed lunch to eat at the studios, and any snacks they may like to leave on the coach for the return journey. Students are welcome to bring some money to purchase food at the studios or at the services on the journey back if they wish, though the cost of food and drink at the studios is quite expensive. There will also be plenty of gift shops selling Harry Potter merchandise, which students may like to purchase, but these are also likely to be pricey. We would also stress that if students wish to buy a 'butter beer' to drink at the studios, they should have only one; they are loaded with sugar and it's a long journey back home!

Although it will be a long day of travelling, we hope that it will be a very memorable experience for students (the English Department are certainly very excited).
