Transport

Transport to and from Fairfield is the responsibility of parents and carers and we ask that parents collect their child promptly each day at 3:30pm. Students are allowed to walk home, as they might when they begin school in September.

Medical and Emergency Contacts

Please ensure you've completed the registration form before Friday 4th July, (at the start of the letter). It is essential that we have the most up to date medical and emergency contact information should we need it.

Conduct

We expect all children to behave sensibly and appropriately throughout the week, upholding the values of our school.

If we feel your child is not behaving in a manner that we expect and is not willing to follow instructions of our staff, parents and carers will be required to collect their child immediately and there is a strong possibility they will not be able to return to any of the remaining sessions, in which case no monies will be refunded.

Kit

School uniform is not required for the week; however, we ask that clothing is comfortable and appropriate for the events held. Parents and carers are asked to remind students that they will be involved in a wide range of activities each day and will need to be in clothing that allows them to be active and is functional: this is not a fashion show!
