**Year 11 Geography: Borth sea defences and Ynyslas sand dune succession**  
**Assessment Data Collection; Friday 10<sup>th</sup> September 2021**

Fieldwork is an integral part of GCSE Geography Exam Paper 3 and therefore we will be taking all Yr 11 Geography students on a field trip on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> September. In the morning we will go to Borth and in the afternoon to Ynyslas. This will enhance their understanding of both the characteristics of coastal defence management and sand dune succession in Ynyslas. The data will then be written up and analysed as practice for Exam Paper 3.

- **All** students will arrive at normal school start time, however due to the distance to travel we will be back at 5 pm and students will need to be collected from school/ walk home if they live locally. Please note we will be not be dropping off students at different places on the way back.
- Students should wear **layers** of suitable **warm** casual clothes and must bring a **waterproof coat**, regardless of the weather. They **must** have **sensible footwear** with a good grip. If the weather is forecasted to be warm we will expect students to bring a sun hat and sun cream.
- All students will have lunch provided at 'The Ship' in Borth (and will pre-order at school before). However, they will need to bring a drink (no energy or fizzy drinks) to have at lunch and throughout day. If they bring money they can buy an extra soft drink at lunch should they wish to.
- Students will need **pens, pencils and a clipboard** to make notes on the worksheets and a **plastic bag** to protect their work in the case of rain. Students may bring a **camera** if they wish (at their own risk) to supplement their project work with photographs from the day which can be annotated in their analysis.
