Fairfield Summer Activities Week Monday August 23nd - Friday August 27th

We are pleased to confirm that the Summer Activities Week is going ahead and please accept this letter as confirmation that your child has a place. If you no longer wish to send your child please let me know and I will update our records.

Cost

The cost of the week is £15 per child to cover resources. (There is no charge for pupil premium children). Payment can be made via Parent Pay for our current Year 7s.

Year 6 parents, please bring cash or cheque on the day. Cheques can be made payable to Fairfield High School.

Timings

Each day will run from 9am to 3.30pm. Student's need to be signed in and out at reception. A member of staff will be on hand to register your child each day.

Food and Drink

Children will need to bring a packed lunch; other drinks and snacks will be provided. A kit list for each day can be found at the end of the letter.

Transport

Transport to and from Fairfield is the responsibility of parents and carers and we ask that parents collect their child promptly each day at 3:30pm.

Activities

The week will be a mixture of crazy Science, Multi-Skills sports, learning to cook fun Food, CSI maths and literacy games and investigations, action packed Drama workshops and creative crafts of all sorts. To get the most out of the week, children will need to attend every day if they can; the cost is fixed.

The activities will be led by Fairfield staff and the AS Creatives company, and we have worked hard to make sure it will be good fun and never boring!

Kit

School uniform is not required for the week, however, we ask that clothing is appropriate and comfortable, it is not a fashion show.

Students will be involved in a wide range of activities each day and will need to be in clothing that allows them to be active and is functional.
